Tips for Avian Migrate® Users

- Always read and follow label directions.
- Shake or stir Avian Migrate® container before each use.*
*Avian Migrate® may “gel” below 50°F. Store in room temperature one day before use.
- Avian Migrate® irritates the taste buds of geese and birds discouraging them from visiting the area. Several weekly applications may be required for Avian Migrate® to be completely effective.
- Treat the grass/turf after every cutting/mowing or heavy rain.
- Begin spraying before geese have established their nests.
- For use near lakes or streams, start application on grass/turf closest to body of water.

How to mix Avian Migrate® solution... add Avian Migrate® to your sprayer first then fill with water

(Residential Users)

To Treat:	<u>¼ acre</u>	<u>½ acre</u>
Avian Migrate®	6.5 oz.	13 oz.
InvisiDye™ (optional, see back)	½ oz.	1 oz.
Water	Fill to one-gallon mark	Fill to two-gallon mark

(Commercial Users)

To Treat:	<u>1 acre or greater</u>
Avian Migrate®	26 oz. per acre
InvisiDye™ (optional, see back)	2 oz. per acre
Water	Enough water to cover entire acreage to be treated

- Avian Migrate® Goose and Bird Control should be applied in a fine mist. Do Not spray to the point of runoff.
- Avian Migrate® Goose and Bird Repellent may stain or darken some surfaces such as walls, fences and other structures. Check first to determine its effect.
- Avoid using Avian Migrate® Goose and Bird Repellent on dwellings such as homes, cabins and other occupied buildings.

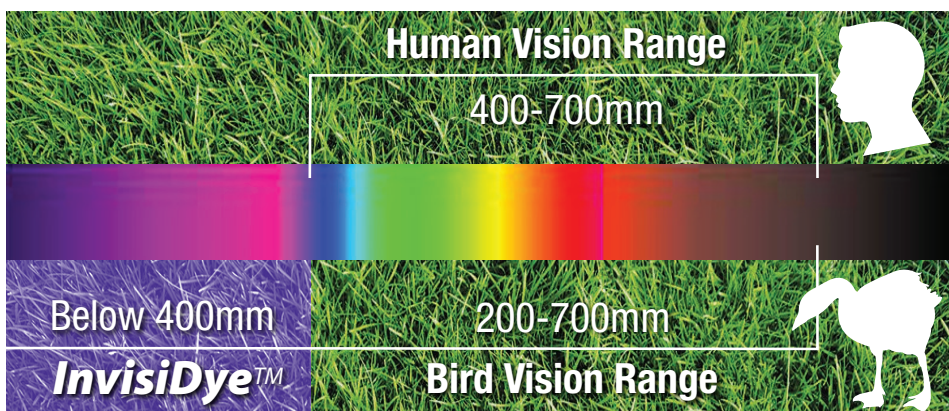

What is InvisiDye™ UV Marker?

InvisiDye™ UV Marker is a non-lethal UV (ultra violet) marker training tool, that when teamed with Avian Migrate® Goose and Bird Repellent, teaches geese and birds to avoid treated grass, plants and landscaping.

How does InvisiDye™ UV Marker work?

By visually training birds to associate irritation with an area treated with a UV marker. Geese and other birds can see UV light waves (200-400nm) which allows them to see a portion of the light spectrum that is invisible to the human eye.

Mix 1/2 oz of InvisiDye™ UV Marker and 6.5 oz of Avian Migrate® per gallon of water to make the application solution. Treat areas where birds feed, roost or congregate according to Avian Migrate® Goose and Bird Repellent label instructions.
